One of the projects Erin was involved in while in the Dominican Republic was the renovating of a house that will serve as a student center in the town of Rio San Juan. The group did everything from painting walls to pouring concrete. She said it was hard work, too.

Erin, and the others in the group, also were able to assist in conducting a VBS and teen devotionals during the week. She was impressed with the sweetness and willingness to learn she witnessed in the children.

In her report letter, Erin wrote: "I learned a lot through the Dominican culture itself. Everything there is not focused around a set schedule and strict time restrains. The main focus in the Dominican Republic is relationships. I cannot think of a better way to grow the Kingdom of God than through building relationships." What a wonderful insight.
