

TWO REACTIONS

The Barna group reported recently that when Christians (as they define them) say which parent impacted their faith the most, 68% say it was their mothers and 46% say it was their fathers.

This is not a new trend. In 1907, Barna released a study which concluded the same thing: mothers have a larger impact on the faith of a child than do fathers. Mothers are more likely than fathers to attend church, pray, read the Bible, talk about spiritual matters, etc.

It seems we should change the title of the song to "Faith of Our Mothers."

I have two reactions to this information.

First, I am thankful for good and godly mothers who train their children spiritually. Today, Mother's Day 2019, is an especially good day to honor their memory or express appreciation to the women in our lives who have impacted us in a positive way spiritually.

Second, come on, guys. Let's fulfill our responsibility in this matter. We like it when preachers talk about the fact that we are the head of the family. We like to remind our wives of that. But, headship involves being the spiritual leader of the family, too.

Remember that Paul wrote, "And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord" (Eph. 6:4).

I realize that there are many single parent families these days, but the ideal situation is when mothers and fathers work together to impact their children spiritually in a positive way.
