Stuart was a West Point graduate. He was nicknamed "The Eyes of the Army." Without question, he was General Robert E. Lee's most trusted general.

Whenever there was some especially dangerous, clandestine mission to be carried out, Lee call on Jeb Stuart. His bravery and ability to gather intelligence under the most difficult of conditions were unparalleled.

At the end of each mission, General Stuart would send his report to Lee and sign it, "Yours to count on, Jeb Stuart. I like that. Jeb Stuart wanted General Lee to know that he could always count on him.


FAMILY MATTERS
