

A LABOR OF LOVE

Genesis 29 tells the interesting story of Jacob taking Leah and Rachel as his wives. You may remember that Jacob wanted Rachel and agreed with her father, Laban, to work seven years for her.

At the end of the seven years, Laban gave Jacob his older daughter, Leah. He explained that it was their custom not to give the younger daughter in marriage before the older one. Jacob agreed to serve another seven years for Rachel.

Fourteen years of service for Rachel's hand in marriage! Why? How? The answer is rather simple, "So Jacob served seven years for Rachel, and they seemed only a few days to him, because of the love he had for her" (Gen. 29:20). Although it was a long time in one sense, it didn't seem so to Jacob, because he was motivated by love.

In the New Testament, Paul explained that his service for Christ was also a labor of love. "For the love of Christ compels us..." (2 Cor. 5:14). This lets us know how Paul could work so tirelessly and remain faithful to the Lord in spite of severe persecutions. He knew that Christ loved him, and he loved Christ.

Some today may serve out of a sense of duty (Rev. 2:1-7), for the praise they might receive from men (Matt. 6:2,8), or for any number of other impure motives. The only service, however, that is joyous for the person and pleasing to Gold is service that is motivated by love.
