They did have power, but they didn't have TV, they didn't have A/C, and most of them didn't have doors.

Overall, we were successful in our trip. We had 11 baptisms! 11 people added to the Lord's church. 2 people were restored to the church. There was 1 marriage, so that they could be baptized. We went to 229 houses for Bible study attempts. We made contact with 424 people. We had Bible studies with 239 people.

The purpose for me writing this is to thank you for the love, prayers, and support. Also, this is to show that that it wasn't for nothing. I learned some things. Thank you again for the support and everything you have done to have made it possible. I do plan on going again next year!
