John DeBerry served in the Tennessee House of Representatives for 25 years. He is the former Chairman of the Black Caucus of State Legislators and Former Chairman of the Children and Family Affairs Committee. Currently, he is a Senior Advisor to Tennessee's Governor, Bill Lee.

He is President of John J. DeBerry and Associates, which is a marketing, advertising, and public relations firm.

Most importantly, John has been a minister of the gospel since 1968, and is currently serving with the Coleman Avenue church of Christ in Memphis.

He is a graduate of the University of Memphis and Freed-Hardeman University. He also attended Christian Brothers University, where he studied marketing and computer programing.

John was married to his wife, Georgia, for more than 40 years prior to her death in 2015. The DeBerry's have two daughters, Chevida and Victoria.
