### **STAND UP!**

In Ephesians 6:11-17, Paul portrays, in the figure of a Roman solder's armor, the armor of God, which is to be worn by Christians. The purpose of this armor is to enable us to "stand against the wiles of the devil" (Eph. 6:11).

Verse 13 says, "Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

The next verse, verse 14, adds, "Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness."

In these verses, the idea of standing firm leaps out at us. Christians are in a life-and-death struggle against Satan and his minions. We know what the ultimate outcome will be, but in the meanwhile we must fight on.

Christians are often timid and seek to avoid any confrontation. Ephesians 5:11, however, says, "And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them."
